St. Bridget laid strong foundations for the Church in Ireland. Her feast day is February 1st, the first day of the Celtic Spring.

It's hard to believe, but I have finished my first year as pastor of St. Bridget Parish.

Rule number one for new pastors is not to change anything in your first year... least of all the Mass schedule.

When I arrived, Msgr. Krempa had mentioned that he was thinking of adding a second Mass on Sunday. After my first year here - seeing how well attended that Mass is - I can see

why. More often than not, it is standing room only.

Therefore, I am considering adding a second Mass on Sunday. I would like your feedback regarding the time of the Mass. I'm offering the following options:

Morning 7 AM • Noon • Evening 5 PM

I'm not offering an 11AM Mass because we have religious education classes at 10:30 AM; I don't want a situation where parents attend Mass while their kids attend class. The Eucharist is a central part of our spiritual lives. Families should be there together. The second Mass would be added to the schedule at the start of the new religious education year. Once added, we'll keep it.

Again, I would appreciate hearing from you about the best option for the second Mass. I will let you know the results at the end of July. And please don't let the fact that I am not a morning person in any way influence your thoughts about an early morning Mass.

Saint of the Week

St. Jeanne-Marie Kerguin

Jeanne-Marie was born on May 5, 1864, at Belle-Isle en Terre, France. She was born to a poor peasant family. Her mother died when she was very young, and she was forced to take over the household chores for the family. Jeanne-Marie joined the Franciscan Missionaries of Mary in 1887, with the name Marie Santa Natalia. There she happily threw herself into a life of devotion. She was assigned first to Paris, then to Carthage in Northern Africa. Sr. Marie Santa Natalia encountered health problems and was sent to Rome to recover. There she answered the call of her Order to work as a missionary. Sr. Marie Santa Natalia arrived in China in March 1899 and was almost immediately hospitalized for several months with typhus. Her short-lived career ended during a crackdown on foreign missionaries during the Boxer Rebellion. St. Jeanne - Marie Kerguin was beheaded on July 9, 1900, at Taiyuanfu, China. Jeanne-Marie's fest day is July 8.
